**Deadline for submission of abstracts 10 February 2012**

**Presenters/authors wishing to submit a paper should note the following:**

1. Abstracts must be provided in electronic format by no later than **10 February 2012**. They may be either:
  - sent as an email attachment to [wa@eh.org.au](mailto:wa@eh.org.au) ;
  - mailed on a CD, USB memory key or other form of transportable memory device to the Conference Convenor (PO Box 2220 MIDLAND DC WA 6936)
2. Abstracts should include presenter's name, title of the paper, and should be accompanied by a 'Call for Paper - Abstract' form. Abstracts must be on a single page, word-processed, 1.5 spacing, maximum 250 words and preferably in Arial font 10 point.
3. Presenters are also required to submit a short biography (maximum 150 words) that may be used as an introduction on the 'Call for Paper – Personal / Contact Details' form.
4. If there is more than one presenter, each presenter must fill out a separate 'Call for papers' form
5. The preferred programme for presentations is Microsoft Power Point.
6. Plenary presentations are generally 25 minutes plus question time and will be held between 9am and 5pm on the Thursday and Friday of the conference.
7. Authors/presenters will be notified of the acceptance of papers by the **20<sup>th</sup> February 2012**. The decision regarding the acceptance of papers is at the discretion of the organising committee.
8. Following notification, further information will be emailed to all presenters along with details of the date and time of your presentation.
9. Final presentation material e.g. PowerPoint presentations must be sent to the Conference Convenor **14 days prior** to conference, being the **14 March 2012** so that we can ensure compatibility with our AV system.
10. Full papers are not required although as proceedings may be published it is advisable for recognition of research points or other for other research documentation.
11. In recognition of your contribution to the EHA conference, presenters will be offered one day's registration (including lunch and morning/afternoon tea) on the day of their presentation.
12. The EHA does not offer remuneration, travel or accommodation costs for those offering to present a paper.
