This year's theme is 'GLOBAL ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC HEALTH: STANDING UP TO PROTECT EVERYONE'S HEALTH EACH AND EVERY DAY'.

For this year's competition, EHA is asking students to highlight how environmental health is crucial to public health on a global scale. You are encouraged to focus on a specific aspect of environmental health and explain how it interconnects with other areas of public health.

It is important to note that any posters submitted to this competition are also eligible to be submitted by students into the IFEH International Congress on Environmental Health being held in Perth next May.

To participate in this competition, you will be required to create one of the following;

- A report of no more than 1,000 words
- A scientific poster
- A short video of not more than 1 minute
- A poem
- A collage

Please submit all entries to <u>samantha.smith@eh.org.au</u> by midnight (EST) on the 19th of September 2023 and be sure to read the submission guidelines on the back of this document carefully before submitting. Winners will be announced on the 26th of September via the EHA social media channels and through direct email.

The overall winner will be invited to attend their local State Conference, or the IFEH World Congress with EHA covering registration costs^{*}. Submission will also be featured in the EHA National Newsletter, on EHA social media channels and submitted to The International Federation of Environmental Health to be featured on their WEHD website page.

*Please note major prize winner will be required to arrange their own flights and accommodation. Students are responsible for submitting any posters to the IFEH World Congress competition.

The winning submission from each university will be showcased in their local states EHA newsletter, on EHA social media channels and receive an EHA prize pack.

Guidelines for report:

- 1. Please use Times New Roman / Calibri / Arial font minimum size 10.
- 2. Submit in .PDF format only.
- 3. Title your report
- 4. Include your university name / logo, your course title and your full name/s in the report header.
- 5. Your submission can be as an individual or part of a group.
- 6. One submission per student.

Guidelines for poster:

1. The poster may include text, figures, charts, tables, images, and artwork but not audio, video or animation.

- 2. The poster must include all contributors names and your university name/logo.
- 3. Text is limited to 200 words.
- 4. The poster can be in the .PDF / .PNG/ JPG format and must be A1 size.
- 5. All unoriginal images/graphics must be credited on the infographic.
- 6. Please use the same font as your report.
- 7. Be careful to respect copyright and personal anonymity with your images or photos.

Guidelines for Video:

- 1. Submit in MP4 format only All videos should be submitted via GoogleDrive or DropBox.
- 2. It is your responsibility to check for copyright infringements/conflicts.
- 3. The video must include credits with mention to any externally sourced visual/audio content.
- 4. The video must include your university name / logo, your course title and your full name/s (this can be included in the credits).

Guidelines for Poem:

- 1. Please use Times New Roman / Calibri / Arial font minimum size 10.
- 2. Submit in .PDF format only.
- 3. Any poem style is permitted.
- 4. No word limit however, only one single sided A4 page may be used
- 5. Include your university name / logo, your course title and your full name/s in the report header.

Guidelines for Collage:

- 1. Submit in .PDF / .PNG / .JPEG format only.
- 2. Original images only
- 3. Collage must fit onto an A4 page
- 4. Include your university name / logo, your course title and your full name/s in the header or footer.
