- An oral presentation (25 minute presentation + 5 minute discussion)
- A short presentation on current projects / research / local issues (10 minutes + 5 minute discussion)
- A visual poster presentation

Abstract Content

The title should be brief and be representative of the content in your presentation. All authors should be listed, followed by the author/s organisation

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- The name of the presenter should be marked with an asterisk (\*)
- The presenter's full contact details to be included.

## Abstract Guidelines

- Abstracts to be presented in Times New Roman, 12 font
- Approximately 200 words of text is required
- Abstracts are to be submitted to the QLD Executive Officer by email as a Word attachment
- The abstract should outline the important points of the presentation and highlight the content to be communicated. It could include the aims, methods, results and conclusions of the work, research, project or case study. Abstracts should <u>not</u> include tables, figures or references.

## **Terms and Conditions**

All presenting authors will be required to register for the conference in order to ensure their abstract is included in the final program. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: The primary presenter will receive a complimentary registration for the day of the presentation. Where multiple people are delivering one presentation, the second presenter will be required to register and will receive a 50% discount off the daily registration rate. If you would like to attend the remainder of the conference, a daily attendance rate is applied.

By submitting an abstract you give consent to publication of the abstract in conference material.

All abstracts must be original work. The author is responsible for the accuracy of the abstract. All submissions must be emailed to the QLD Executive Officer at <u>qld@eh.org.au</u>.

# FORMAT: Please indicate the proposed format of your presentation – all submissions will be reviewed by the conference committee.



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#### Plenary / Oral Presentation

Full paper and slide presentation (25 minutes + 5 minutes for discussion)

#### **Short Presentation** *of current projects / research / local issues*

*Full paper and slide presentation. These presentations should briefly inform and challenge delegates on topical issues. (15 minutes)* 

#### **Poster Presentation**

Poster presentations are visual displays of material that constitute an interactive and communicative medium, usually combining text and graphic information. Posters can be on any topic relevant to the conference theme. Posters will be displayed in the exhibition area for the duration of the conference. It is expected that the presenter will be available during meal breaks to discuss the poster with conference delegates.

#### **GUIDELINES:**

- Abstracts to be presented in Times New Roman, 12 font.
- Approximately 200 words of text is required.
- Identify the theme and include objectives and brief outline of presentation.
- Submit your abstract as an email with a <u>Word attachment</u>.
- All presenters must register for the conference, there is no charge for the day of the presentation.
- Abstracts to be received by COB 28 February 2025.
