

Memorandum of Understanding between EHA and CIEH

Requirements to practice as a qualified Environmental Health Practitioner / Environmental Health Officer between countries:

England, Wales or Northern Ireland > Australia



The following credentials need to be held by the applicant for the person to be qualified in England, Wales or Northern Ireland and practice as an EHP/EHO in Australia:

- Completion of a university level course recognised by the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health (CIEH) Professional Standards Framework v1.4
- Applicants planning to work in Western Australia will need to apply for recognition through the Western Australian Environmental Health Professional Review Board (as is the case for non-Western Australian EHOs/EHPs)

England, Wales or Northern Ireland > Australia



The following credentials need to be held by the applicant for the person to be qualified in Australia and practice as an EHP/EHO in England, Wales or Northern Ireland:

- Completion of a university level course accredited by Environmental Health Australia (EHA)
- Completion of a short course* approved by the Chartered Institute of Environmental Health (CIEH) the covers the areas of housing included in the CIEH Professional Standards Framework**
- Takes the food inspection exam approved by the CIEH

Such applicants can then progress to registered EHP and Chartered status via the pathways set out in the CIEH's Registration Regulations.
