Eligibility:	<p>A person with a qualification other than those qualifications providing eligibility for Member Class. (This includes a person who possesses a VET qualification at the level of Certificate IV or above in environmental or health related areas).</p>
Voting Rights:	1 vote

Eligibility:	The conditions of entry to become a Student Member are that the applicant must be undertaking an undergraduate or postgraduate degree in an environmental or health related field.

Eligibility:	Has been a financial member for a minimum of 2 years within the class of an Associate Member, Member, Fellow and have temporarily ceased employment.
Voting Rights:	1 vote
Benefits & Entitlements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newsletters, Website Access, Journal of Environmental Health Participation at networks and special interest groups.
Conditions	Minimum leave of absence period is 6 months. Maximum leave of absence period is 12 months. Request for access to the Temporary Inactive Member must be in writing. A maximum of 2 consecutive years as a Temporary Inactive Member may be approved.
Membership Fee:	No Fee or Pro rata applied. Added to the Temporary Inactive List
Part – Time Member	
Eligibility:	Has been a financial member for a minimum of 2 years within the class of an Associate Member, Member, Fellow and work only part-time.
Voting Rights:	1 vote
Benefits & Entitlements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newsletters, Website Access, Journal of Environmental Health Attendance at all conferences and workshops at member rates Ability to fill any office bearer positions Participation at networks, committees, seminar/conference organisation & special interest groups May use the post nominal associates with their normal class of membership Access to CPD and CEHT or CEHP programs Reduced membership fee (60%)
Conditions	Must provide documentation from employer on part-time status – part-time is considered to be 0.6 FTE or less (ie 3 days a week or less).

Eligibility:	Has been a financial member for a minimum of 10 years within the class of an Associate Member, Member, Fellow, Life Fellow or Honorary Fellow.
