The course includes eight units of study relating to Infection Control,

Clinic Practice and Records, Personal Safety and Occupational Health & Safety Issues, Sterilization and Waste Management.

This unit is offered to those in need of skills and knowledge relating to health care, infection control standards and practice, policies, procedures and controlling regulations. Safety issues relating to client and patient management and record keeping, sterilization and safe personal and clinic practice are also studied. The unit requires analysis and verification of workplace practice.

National Course Codes for the units covered are

HLTIN402B/01 Implement and maintain infection control practices and infection risk containment measures

HLTIN402B/02 Monitor and maintain cleanliness of environment

HLTIN402B/03 Maintain personal protection

HLTIN402B/04 Undertake infection control measures during procedures & treatments

HLTIN402B/05 Clean and sterilize instruments, equipment & implantable items

HLTIN402B/06 Maintain sterilizer equipment

HLTIN402B/07 Maintain awareness of implications of premises layout and maintenance for control of infection risks

HLTIN402B/08 Comply with infection control regulations and standards, and related legal obligations This unit is for clinics where skin penetration happens. It is designed to cover the issues of personal safety, client & co-worker well-being. Policies & procedures for safety in a working environment are analysed for implementation. The unit offers reading and research materials and requires practical observation and clinical notes to back up a written assignment.

Support materials such as sterilization records, photographs of the work place, and a letter of support from an on-site observer will be required as a part of the assessment if the course is done by self-paced correspondence.

Discussion & support from a Tutor with contact via mail, phone or email will be available. This unit is valued Australia – wide but is a requirement, at this stage, in Queensland for any practitioner of skin penetration
